






 - Facilitate the organ recovery process













- 1. Death declaration
- 2. Observation for auto-resuscitation
- 3. Incision
- 4. Vessel occlusion & cannulation
- 5. Machine perfusion
- 6. Organ function evaluation
- 7. Cross-clamp
- 8. Rapid organ recovery, backtable, & packaging

- Viability assessment in warm ischemic state
- Reduces risk of organ injury during procurement
- Minimizes organ warm ischemia
- Reduces post-transplant complications and graft loss
- Expands potential organs for transplant
- Cost reduction v. machine perfusion



- Process mirrors traditional DCD through death declaration
- Minimal OR adjustments
 - Transplant centers provide most equipment and staff for perfusion
 - Slight increase in OR time
 - Lab requests



Donor Hospital NRP Impact

- Organs that might not have been recovered through traditional NRP are now considered
- Authorization process
 - No additional authorization required
- How much detail should be shared with donor families?
 - American Society of Transplant position was that a clear communication plan should be established



Donor Family NRP Impact

Donor family focus group

- Facilitated by Live On Nebraska
- 7 previous donor families participated
- "During the donation process, what information did you want to receive about the surgical recovery?"
 - "I wanted to know my loved one would not be feeling any pain. His comfort was my only concern."
 - "If I wanted to know more, I would have asked."
 - "That is your loved one. You don't want to think about that part (surgery). You want to know about the happy part, the recipients."



Donor Family NRP Impact

- Live On Nebraska donor family messaging position
 - Offer to provide as much or as little information as the family wants
 - Messaging is directed by the donor family



Donor Family NRP Impact

- 13 NRP DCD donors in Nebraska from 2021-2023
- 17 organs transplanted that would not have been with traditional DCD



- Increased Abdominal NRP
- Expanded NRP donor suitability
