ABOUT THE COURSE

PALS is a nationally recognized program designed by the American Heart Association to train pediatric health care providers in managing critically ill infants and children. This comprehensive course combines small group lectures, hands-on demonstrations, case-based scenario evaluations, and skill practice to ensure effective learning and application in real-world situations.

The **PALS Provider** is a two-day course designed for health care providers who are new to PALS, would like to enhance their knowledge and skills, or need to renew an expired PALS card.

The **PALS Renewal** is a one-day course designed for health care providers who have previously completed an PALS Provider course and have a solid understanding of its content.

Prerequisite: Current AHA BLS Provider card AND Current PALS Provider card

Credit: 7 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™
