Advancing Transgender Care in the Heartland



Asa Radix, MD, MPH, FACP

Senior Director of Research and Education, Callen-Lorde Community Health Center; Assistant Clinical Professor, New York University, New York City, NY

Dr. Asa Radix is clinician, educator and researcher whose main area of expertise is in transgender health. Asa is currently the Senior Director of Research and Education at the Callen-Lorde Community Health Center, a center that predominantly cares for the LGBT communities in New York City. After completing undergraduate medical training in the West Indies, Asa trained in internal medicine and infectious diseases at the University of Connecticut and later completed postgraduate qualifications in tropical medicine and public health in the United Kingdom. In addition to having a clinical practice (mainly HIV primary care and transgender health), Asa coordinates electives in LGBT Health for medical and nursing students and is an assistant clinical professor of medicine at NYU and Yale.

Dr. Radix has presented both nationally and internationally on LGBT issues, has published widely in the field of transgender health, and has assisted in developing guidelines in transgender health for the World Health Organization, the Pan American Health Organization and The Asia Pacific Transgender Network.
