This symbol shows an event where groups will be divided so that each activity happens in shifts. We will explain this to you and help you get to where you need to go!



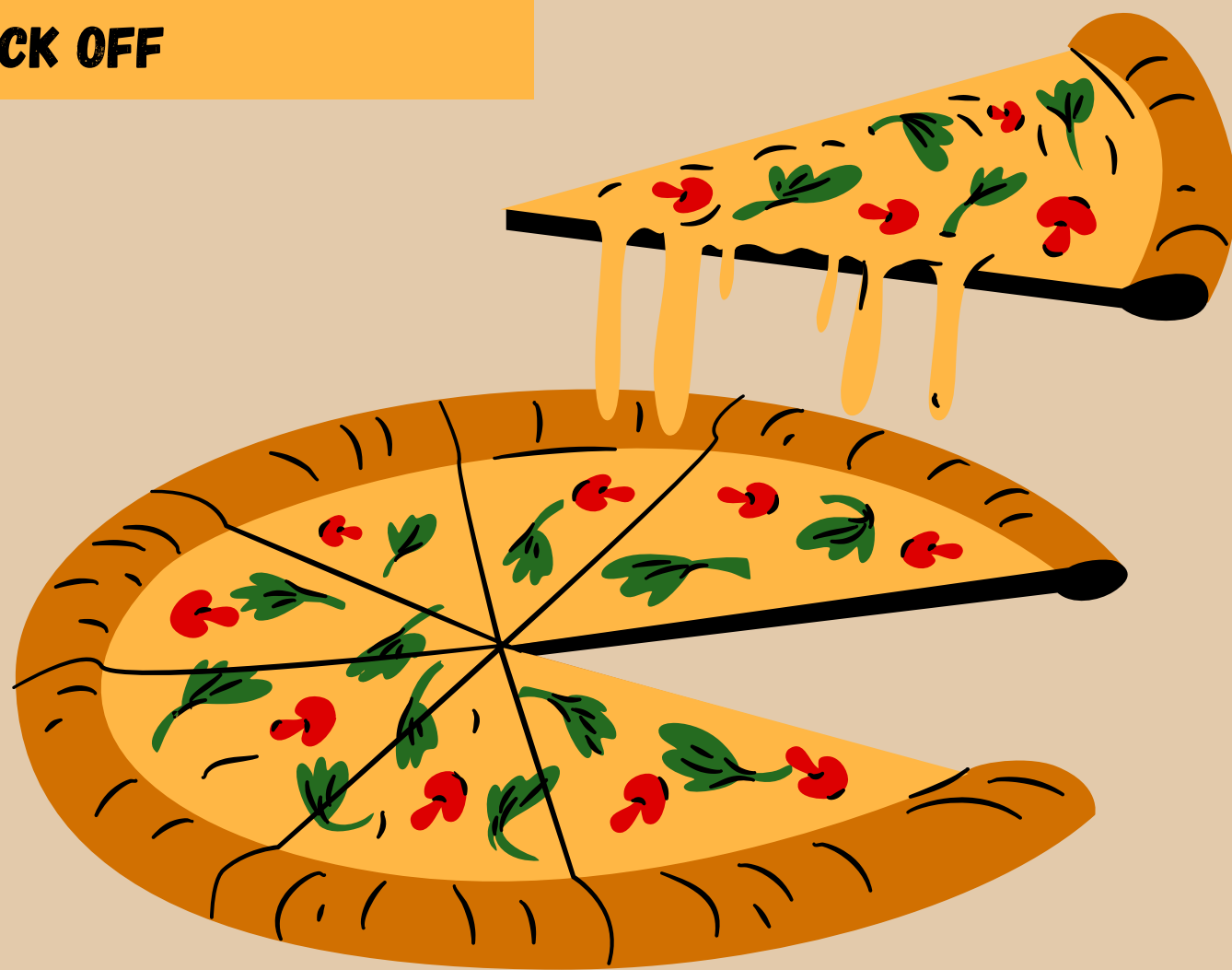
