Faculty Clinical and Basic Science Research Awards

- 1. Assistant & Associate Professor levels
- 2. Evidence of an *emerging and independent* research career as supported by publications and extramural funding in the investigator's area of interest.
- 3. Evidence of an *emerging* regional or national reputation in their area of interest as demonstrated by presentations at national meetings, participation in committees or special programs at the regional or national level, etc.
- 4. Other items that the nominator feels reflect how the nominee has shown excellence in their research work.

Fellowship Research and Resident Research Awards
