In 1985, Dr. Windle joined the faculty at UNMC and established the first adult electrophysiology program in Nebraska. In the 1990's he became involved in quality improvement and became the Associate Dean for Continuing Medical Education with a charge to bring computer-based education online. Dr. Windle has spent the past 25 years working to make digital technology work for clinicians with extramural funding from the National Science Foundation, National Institute for Standards and Technology, the National Library of Medicine, and the Agency for Health Care Quality and Research. After 16 years as Chief of the Division of Cardiovascular Medicine, Dr. Windle now concentrates on clinical care and directing the Center for Intelligent Health Care.
