READ/WRITE LEARNERS

CHARACTERISTICS

- Retain information better by reading and/or writing it
- Prefer handouts, textbooks, their own notes, or printed slideshows
- Like writing things out in their words
- Don't mind and even benefit from taking notes

STUDY STRATEGIES

- Remember information well when it is written again and again
- Take notes in class and then re-copy to study
- Use unit objectives to guide your reading of the textbook. Read those sections multiple times and write notes on key concepts
- Re-read material that is tough for you right before bed and again before the exam

THE EXAM

- Immediately "brain dump" tough concepts on your scratch paper
- Re-write questions you are struggling to understand
- Start listing things you do know about a certain topic
 if you aren't sure of the answer
- Read slowly and try to visualize your notes
