AACN The Essentials: Core Competencies for Professional Nursing Education

Entry-Level Professional Nursing Education (BSN)

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The Essentials are divided into 10 domains, which are broad, distinguishable areas of competence to provide a framework for nursing education. Within the 10 domains are competencies, which are short statements of a component of the domain. The sub-competencies are observable & measurable learner outcomes expected for the entry-level professional BSN graduates.
