The Jackson Heart Study (JHS) is the largest and longest running study of cardiovascular disease in African Americans. JHS researcher discoveries include a gene variant in African-Americans doubling heart disease risk, a link between a sickle cell trait and increased kidney disease risk, and that even small blood pressure spikes can lead to a higher risk of death.
