Vacation: Fellow allowed 4 weeks (20 weekdays), Although PTO may be taken during inpatient rotations, time away from these rotations must be pre-approved by the attending during the absence. It is strongly suggested that vacation not be taken from any one clinical rotation more than once in a year so as to avoid diluting each experience. Fellows are also encouraged to not "save" vacation for research time, but rather to take vacations during various clinical rotations so that an ideal balance of clinical, research, and vacation can be achieved.
