OTHER IMPORTANT FIRST AID SUPPLIES

- Eye goggles
- Flashlight/headlamp & extra batteries
- Glucose tablets for people with diabetes
- Safety pins
- Small, sterile adhesive compresses in sealed envelopes
- 2 qt. sterile saline solution
- Tongue depressors
- Tweezers



AIRWAY COMPROMISES:

- Albuterol rescue inhaler (by prescription for asthma)
- Epinephrine autoinjector/EpiPen (by prescription for anaphylaxis)

BLEEDING:

- 4 in. Israeli bandage

BURN MANAGEMENT:

- 12x30 in. trauma dressing or sterile dressing with Telfa rolled gauze

CARDIAC ISSUES:

- Bottle of 81 mg non-coated aspirin for heart attacks

WHERE SHOULD A FIRST AID KIT BE STORED?

A large first aid kit should be kept in all main feedyard buildings, such as machine shops, horse barns, feedmill, and the main office. Smaller kits should be kept in vehicles and other farm equipment. Store kits in weatherproof containers. First aid kits should be inspected at least quarterly and replenished as needed. Items that are past their expiration date should be removed and replaced.
