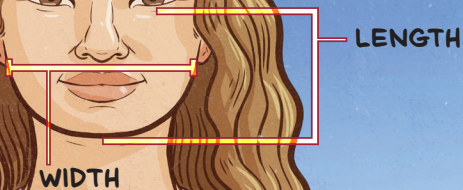


Respirator Fit is Important

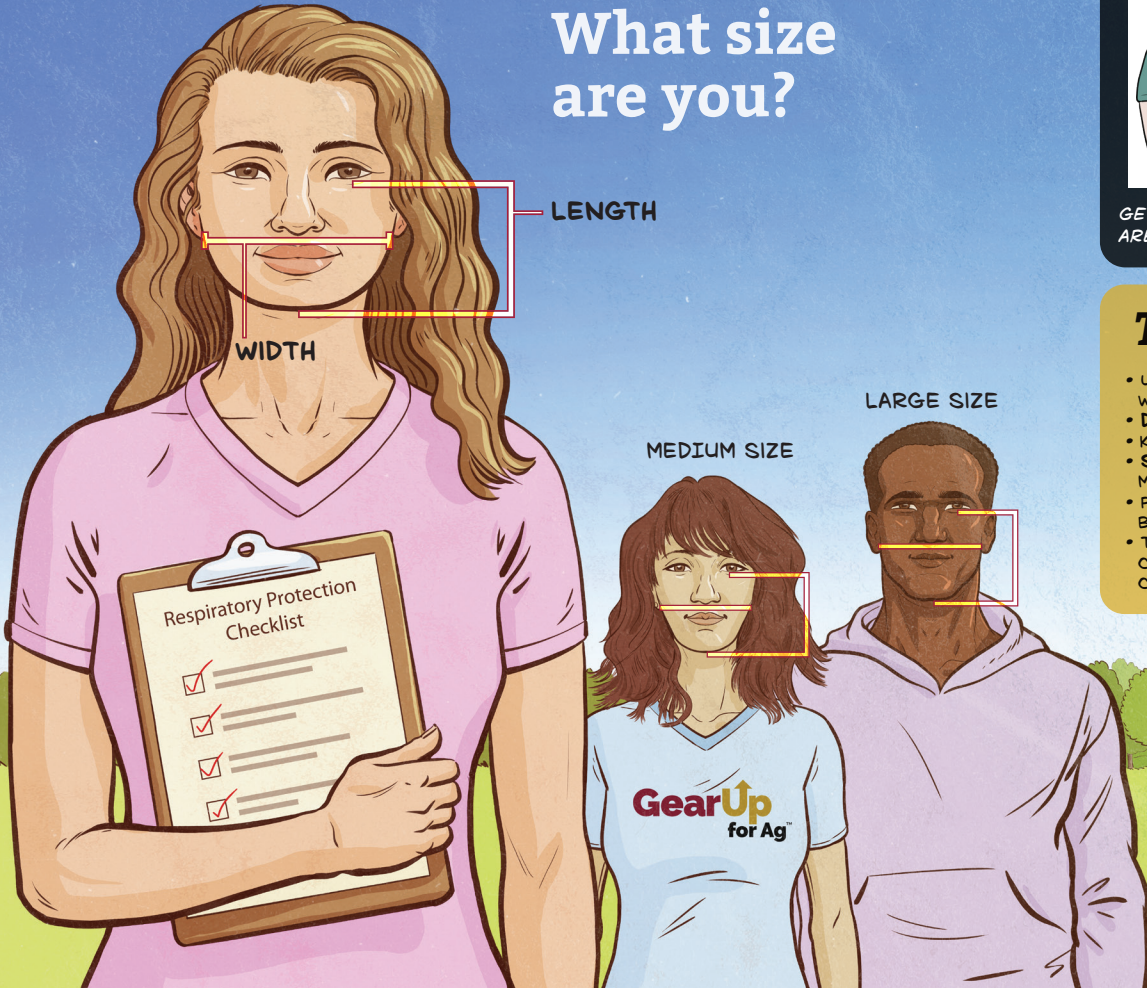
SMALL FACE SIZE

Fit = Protection and Comfort



GET FIT TESTED TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE GETTING THE BEST PROTECTION.

Know when to wear a respirator in agriculture:

- MOVING LIVESTOCK/LOAD OUTS
- WORKING WITH HAY FEED OR FEED STUFFS
- WORKING WITH MECHANIZED FEED SYSTEMS
- CLEANING PENS AND HOUSING, ESPECIALLY WITH DISINFECTANTS
- DISPOSAL OF CARCASSES OR PLACENTAL MATERIALS
- POWERWASHING
- WORKING IN DUSTY BARNs, SUCH AS FARROWING
- KNOWN OR SUSPECTED DISEASE OUTBREAKS (HUMANS AND/OR ANIMALS)
- PESTICIDES OR PEST TREATMENTS (SUCH AS DEWORMER, FLY CONTROL)
- CLEANING GRAIN BINS/GRAIN HANDLING

Tips for wearing your respirator:

- USE THE **RIGHT** RESPIRATOR FOR THE JOB, WITH THE CORRECT FIT
- **DO NOT** USE OTHER PEOPLE'S RESPIRATOR
- KEEP RESPIRATOR **CLEAN**, AND STORE CORRECTLY
- **STORE** THE RESPIRATOR IN A BREATHABLE BAG MARKED WITH YOUR NAME
- PULL **LONG HAIR** INTO A PONYTAIL AND PLACE BETWEEN THE RESPIRATOR STRAPS
- TO **COMMUNICATE** WITH OTHERS, PULL THE CRADLE DOWN OR USE THE "QUICK RELEASE" ON CARTRIDGE RESPIRATORS
- **DISCARD** DISPOSABLE RESPIRATOR IF IT BECOMES DIRTY, WET OR HARD TO BREATHE THROUGH
- **REPLACE** OR DISCARD CARTRIDGES IF YOU SMELL OR TASTE HAZARDS OR IF IT BECOMES DIFFICULT TO BREATHE
- **DO NOT USE** RESPIRATORS WITH EXHALATION VALVES IF YOU OR THE ANIMALS YOU WORK WITH ARE SICK
- SCHEDULE TIME FOR **BREAKS** WHEN USING A RESPIRATOR
