### **Patient Eligibility Guidelines**

Those interested in being seen at the SHARING Clinic must meet the following criteria:

- No health insurance
- Annual household income below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level based on 2024 guidelines (see chart below)
- Complete a proof of income application that includes at least one of the following:
  - > Current pay stubs for all household incomes
- > Last federal income tax return
- Documentation of any other income sources or means of support
- Note: Documentation is encouraged but not required to be seen — this can be discussed on a case-by-case basis
