NIH K Awards – The Who?

- Typically, the PD/PI (candidate)
 - At the time of award
 - Holds a full-time appointment at academic institution
 - VA appointments are not counted as part of academic institution appointment
 - U.S. citizen or a non-citizen national or lawfully admitted for permanent residence
 - Must commit 9 PMs (75% effort) to project
- Other eligibility requirements
 - Early Stage Investigator?
 - Potential extension to eligibility period

Salary

The participating NIH Institutes and Centers will provide salary and fringe benefits for the award recipient (see Table of IC-Specific Information, Requirements and Staff Contacts). Further guidance on budgeting for career development salaries is provided in the How to Apply - Application Guide.

In addition, the candidate may derive additional compensation for effort associated with other Federal sources or awards provided the total salary derived from all Federal sources does not exceed the maximum legislated salary rate (see http://grants.nih.gov/grants/policy/salcap_summary.html) and the total percent effort does not exceed 100%. See also NOT-OD-17-094.

Other Program-Related Expenses

The participating NIH Institutes and Centers will provide research development support for the award recipient (Table of IC-Specific Information, Requirements and Staff Contacts). These funds may be used for the following expenses: (a) tuition and fees related to career development; (b) research-related expenses, such as supplies, equipment and technical personnel; c) travel to research meetings or training; and (d) statistical services including personnel and computer time.

Indirect Costs

NIH K Awards – Application SF424 RR: Cover letter

Mentored CDA applications

- Must include a cover letter that contains list of references
 - Name
 - Departmental affiliation
 - Institution



RR Other Project Information: 7. Project Summary/Abstract

- Summarize research project
- Describe candidate's career development plan, candidate's career goals, and environment in which the career development will take place
- Limited to 30 lines of text



NIH K Awards – Application RR Key Person

- PI (candidate)
- Mentor, co-mentors
 - Project role = Other Professional
 - Other project role = Mentor or Co-Mentor
 - Also provide Current & Pending Support
- Collaborators, consultants, advisory committee members, if applicable

NIH K Awards – Application RR Key Person: Current & Pending Support

- Relevant to the candidate's research plan
- Limited to three pages
- Include
 - Project Number
 - Source
 - Major Goals
 - Project / Proposal State and End Dates
 - Total Award Amount
- Do not include
 - Effort
 - Overlap



NIH K Awards – Application RR Budget: A. Senior/Key Persons

Only include PI

- Actual IBS
- Usually 9 PMs (75% effort)
- I/C limit for salary
 - Cost-share in ADIS Internal Forms



RR Budget: F. Other Direct Costs: 1. Material and Supplies

Unless instructed differently in NOFO

- Enter the total research development support (I/C specific)
- All other budget fields (besides Pl salary/benefits) should be left blank
- Details will be provided in Budget Justification



NIH K Awards – Applications RR Budget: L. Budget Justification

- Salary and Benefits (I/C specific) for candidate
- Other Program-Related Expenses (I/C specific)
 - Tuition and fees
 - Supplies, equipment, technical personnel
 - Travel to research meetings or training
 - Statistical services, including personnel and computer time
 - DMSP costs
 - Not allowed: Salary for mentor
- Indirect: 8% MTDC



NIH K Awards – Application PHS Human Subjects and Clinical Trials Information

CDA applicants who are proposing to gain clinical trial research experience under mentor's supervision

 Not all fields are required because study is not an *independent* clinical trial

NIH K Awards (Mentored) – Reference Letters

- At least three, but no more than five
- Individuals not directly involved in application, but familiar with candidate's qualifications
- List referees in cover letter
- Due the same day as application
- Can see in Commons that letters were received, but cannot see letters
- For due dates on or after 1/25/25
 - Updated instructions regarding structure
 - Process will remain the same



NIH K Awards – Reference Letters

- Submitted directly in the Commons (login not required)

 To provide a reference letter for a fellowship or career development applicant https://public.era.nih.gov/commonsplus/public/reference/submitReferenceLetter.era
- Will need to enter
 - Pl's Commons ID
 - Pl's last name
 - NOFO numbers
 - Confirmation number, only if making a change to letter for that application cycle
- Upload PDF, two-page maximum
- Letters are specific to the application cycle



NIH K Awards – Post-Award

- K award recipients are encouraged to obtain funding from other sources
- May be able to reduce effort in final two years
