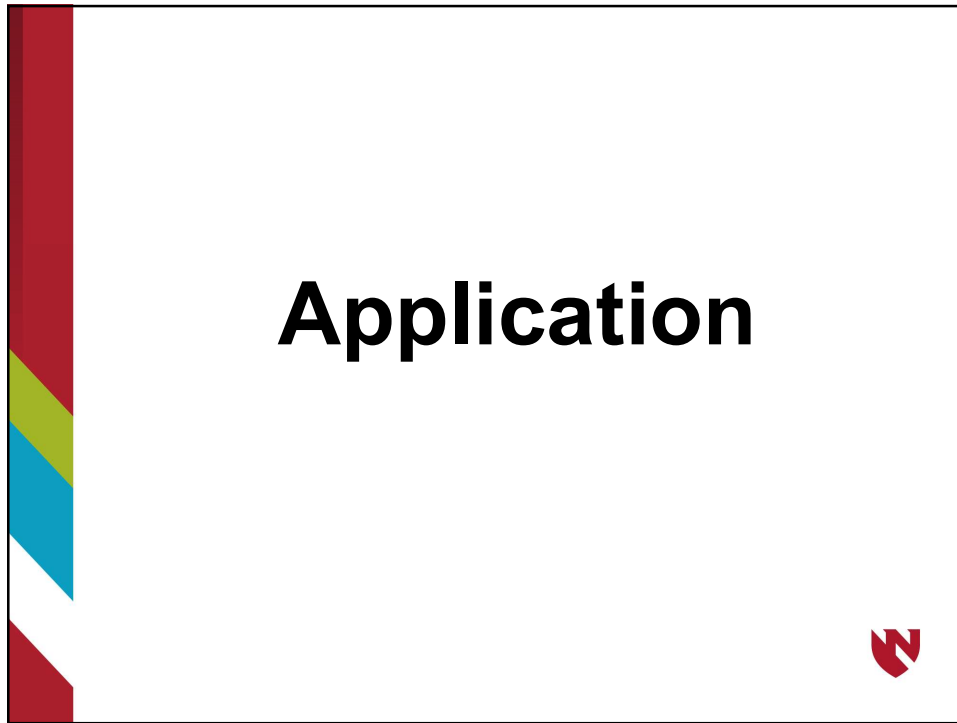

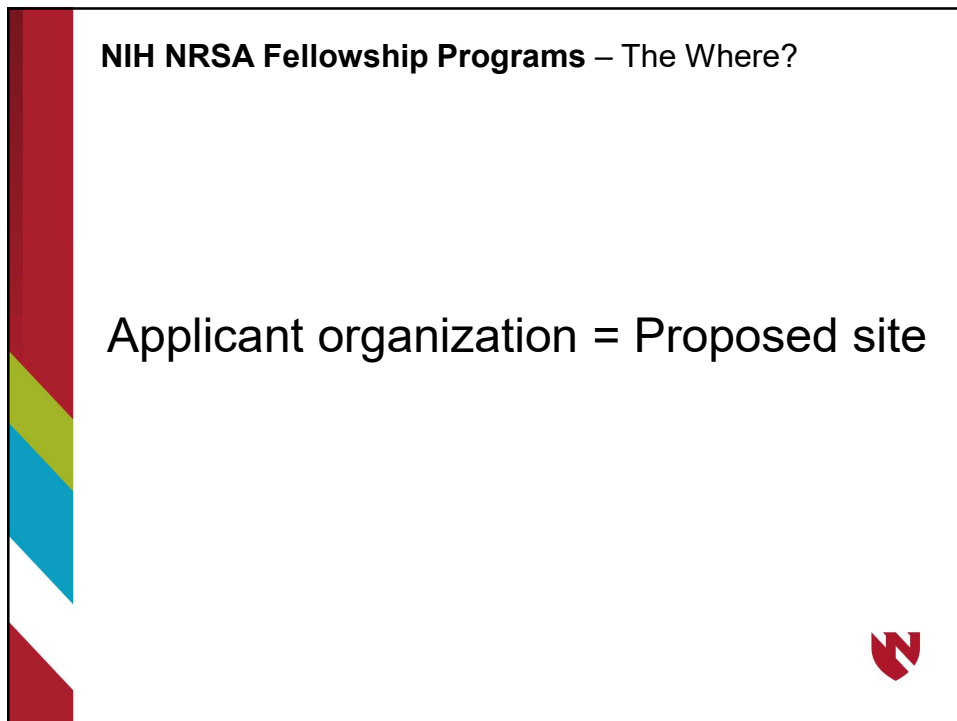

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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Budgeting in ADIS

- Salaries (Wage Code Type # 1016)
 - Use applicable stipend amount as IBS
 - Department may supplement stipend if consistently applied to all individuals in a similar status regardless of the source of funds
- Fringe benefits (Wage Code Type # 1416)
 - Health Insurance is part of Institutional Allowance
 - The amount ADIS calculates for fringe benefits could be:
 - Pre-doc (0.4%): Subtracted from the Institutional Allowance budgeted elsewhere (e.g., in Operating) - *\$112 out of \$4,750*
 - Post-doc (17.2%): Cost-shared - *\$10,493+ out of \$12,400*

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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Letters of Reference


- Due at time of application
- At least three, but no more than five
- From individuals not directly involved in application, but familiar with applicant's qualifications, training, and interests
 - Cannot be sponsor/co-sponsor(s)
- Include list of referees in application **cover letter**
- Referees do not need Commons account
- Resubmissions require new reference letters
- PI can see status in Commons (not letters) 

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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Letters of Reference

To provide a reference letter for a fellowship or career development applicant

- Submitted directly in the Commons (login not required)
 - <https://public.era.nih.gov/commonsplus/public/reference/submitReferenceLetter.era>
- Will need to enter
 - PI's Commons ID
 - PI's last name
 - NOFO number
 - Confirmation number, *only if* making a change to letter for that application cycle
- Upload PDF, two-page maximum
- Letters are specific to the application cycle

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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Human Subjects and Clinical Trials Information

Applicants who are proposing to gain clinical trial research experience under sponsor's supervision

- Not all fields are required because study is not an *independent* clinical trial

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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Documents

- Activation Notice
 - Wet-ink signed, mailed
 - Some ICs accepting electronic versions
 - Should receive email acknowledgement and see update in the Commons
- Payback Agreement (post-doctoral only)
 - Agree to engage in health-related biomedical or behavioral research
- Termination Notice
 - 30 days after end date
 - In xTrain module
 - Stipend pro-rated if terminated early
- Revised NOA (if applicable)
 - If stipend level increases



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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Changes in Budget

- Re-budgeting
 - In most cases, funds are restricted, and prior approval is needed to re-budget between cost categories
- Carry-forward
 - Although individual fellowships are awarded under the NIH Standard Terms of Award, carryover of unobligated balances does not apply (https://grants.nih.gov/grants/policy/nihgps/HTML5/section_11/11.2.13_other_terms_and_conditions.htm#Applicab)
 - Therefore, the last three digits of the WBS # should be advanced each year

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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Other Considerations

Citizenship

- *To be eligible for a Kirschstein-NRSA individual fellowship (F30, F31, F32, F33), the fellowship applicant must be a citizen or non-citizen national of the United States or of its possessions or territories, or must have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence by the time the award is issued*



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NIH NRSA Fellowship Programs – Other Considerations

Taxability of stipends (Wage Code Type 1016)

- *A stipend is provided as a subsistence allowance for Kirschstein-NRSA fellows to help defray living expenses during the research training experience. It is not provided as a condition of employment with either the Federal government or the sponsoring institution.*
- *NIH takes no position on what the status may be for a particular taxpayer, and it does not have the authority to dispense tax advice. Individuals should consult their local IRS office about the applicability of the law to their situation and for information on their tax obligations.*

 - Grades will no longer be required
